Color- the quality of an object or substance with respect to light reflected by the object, usually determined visually by measurement of hue, saturation, and brightness of the reflected light; saturation or chroma; hue.

Glossary- a list of terms in a special subject, field, or area of usage, with accompanying definitions.

Envelope- a flat paper container, as for a letter or thin package, usually having a gummed flap or other means of closure.

Mug- a drinking cup, usually cylindrical in shape, having a handle, and often of a heavy substance, as earthenware.

Boredom- the state of being bored; tedium; ennui.

Crap- Contrast, Repitition, Allignment, Proximity



Logo, Logotype



Use of Space

The logo would be printed on any document looking like this. There is always supposed to be at least a .25 in. gap between it and any other item printed. It should not be tilted in any sort of way. Just right-side up. No alterations should be made to the logo without direct permission. The file may only be printed by those who have access.



Typography

When I was looking for my font, I knew I wanted something flowy. I had gone onto DaFont.com and searched in different categories to decide what I wanted. I soon came across Dirplanes in the Night Sky and knew that it was the one I wanted. For the word Bakery, I needed something bold. So I was testing out different fonts, until I found Perputa.

Color

When picking my colors, I wanted something pretty, but not girly. I decided that the color scheme would be cool colors, like blue and green. I looked through the different colors to find something bright and attractive, while keeping to the blues. I settled on a green tail with a blue outline, and with all the words typed in a blue. Bakery was the darkest blue, and 'Kitten Kakes' and 'Made from Scratch' in a lighter. Bakery was also outlined in black.

Business Card

This is our business card. It is about 2.5 inches wide, and 1 inch tall. It can be printed in one of three colors, light blue, yellow, and purple. The tail in the corner would be, again, cut off by the black line. The writing would be in Perputa.






Envelope

This is my envelope. It would normally be about 5 inches wide, and 2 inches tall. The parts of the tail that is cut off by the black line, would not be printed. The color of the envelope would be a very light blue. (C-6 M-0 Y-0 K-0) The writing would be printed in Perputa.



Letterhead

This is our letterhead. Like the envelope, it has a very light blue background. The edges of the tail would also be cut off by the black line. Our information would be on the bottom. The writing is printed in Perputa.



Mug

This is another one of our products. A mug. It is about 4 inches tall, and made of glass. This is the front design, and the black looks just the same, without the logo. If you bring the mug to a bakery, we can serve you our drinks in it. Just ask. It has a comfortable handle-grip, and costs only 5.99\$.
