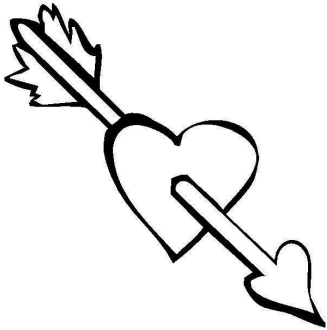


Help these poor broken-hearted men find true political happiness:

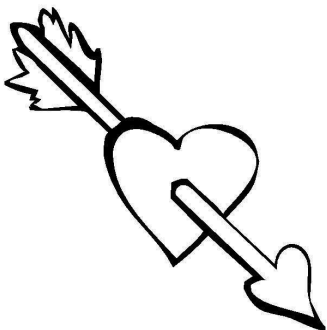
