## Reasons for reduced time

- Replace human-scored items on CAT with machine-scored
- No constructed response questions included on CAT
- All selected response questions


## - Eliminate all Brief Writes on CAT

- Not assessed: Claim 2 (Writing) at Depth of Knowledge 3 (Strategic Thinking \& Reasoning)

Sample question Claim 2, DOK 3
A student is writing an editorial for the local paper about cell phones. Read his rough draft and complete the task that follows. [rough draft] Write an introduction to the editorial that establishes and introduces a clear claim that supports the use of cell phones in schools. (grade 7)

## - Reduce research items on Part 1 of the Performance Task

- The previous test had 2-3 constructed response or multiple selection questions
- There will be one question on Part 1 of the Performance Task
- Part 2 will still include the Full Write (essay)
