

Tootsie Roll CEO dies, still working at 95

This article is about Melvin Gordon. He led Tootsie Roll Industries for more than five decades and he has died at age 95 after a brief illness. This company had produced 64 million Tootsie Rolls a day and other favorites including Junior Mints, Charleston Chews and Tootsie Pops. Tootsie Rolls were invented in 1896 by New York City. The Candy maker Leo Hirshfield named them for his 5-year-old daughter, Clara, who he called “little Tootsie”. I thought the author did a good job writing this article very clearly.
