

School Stipend Plan for International Walk and Bike to School Day

schoolsolutions, a service of **point2point Solutions**, is offering stipends to help local K-12 schools organize Walk and Bike to School events in recognition of the **International Walk and Bike to School Day** on October 6, 2010. Stipends may be used to reimburse schools for the cost of campaign materials and/or student incentives for school events that focus on a day, week, or month associated with the international promotion.

A total of \$5,000 is available to fund the stipends. Stipend amounts will vary based on school enrollment, as shown in the chart below.

School Enrollment	Available Stipend
Fewer than 300 students	Up to \$200
300-500 students	Up to \$350
More than 500 students	Up to \$500

How To Apply

Schools must submit their request to point2point Solutions <u>by September 29, 2010</u>. Requests may be e-mailed to <u>point2point@ltd.org</u>, or mailed to point2point Solutions; PO Box 7070; Eugene, OR 97401. Requests must describe the school's planned event and activities and identify the items to be purchased for the promotion. point2point Solutions staff will notify applicants <u>by Friday</u>, October 1, if their request has been approved.

How to Get Reimbursement

Schools that are pre-approved to receive a stipend must submit a summary on school letterhead of their event, the level of student participation, and the allowable expenses. The reimbursement request must be submitted by October 22, 2010.
