The Eugene Concert Choir's Education Outreach Program (ECCO) is in its third season of bringing an in-class educational presentation to your students as part of our educational mission. A small ensemble of choir singers will present a 35 minute lesson to your class. As the children learn songs from the international folk song repertoire, they are introduced to basic musical concepts such as melody, harmony and rhythm. The students are active participants throughout the presentation.

Your class will receive a CD of the songs presented so you can continue with the lesson content and expand it if you and the children choose. We can also return for additional presentations if requested.
