The Center on Teaching and Learning (CTL) Reading Clinic is offering summer reading camps for struggling readers. New for Summer 2011

Spelling/Fluency Boost

Either in addition to reading or as a stand alone session, children entering 2nd- 4th grade will spend 30 minutes working on spelling and 30 minutes working on fluency building.

Kindergarten Readiness Session

Children entering kindergarten in September 2011 are eligible to attend this readiness group which will focus on phonemic awareness, letter sounds, initial word reading skills, spelling, vocabulary and comprehension. Help your child get a boost before entering kindergarten.
