With the new school year about to begin, I want to update you on a change to The Register-Guard's Newspaper in Education Program.

In order to provide as many classroom copies as possible to our large roster of participating teachers and schools, we will no longer be able to offer delivery of The Register-Guard on Mondays and Tuesdays. This change is necessary based on our projected NIE program funding and the cost of printing and distributing the newspapers to the schools. We will continue to deliver the Wednesday, Thursday and Friday print editions to you. (This change is for our NIE program only and does not affect our home delivery subscription options.)

To supplement the Wednesday through Friday newspapers, all teachers who participate in our NIE program will have free access to The Register-Guard's e-Edition. The e-Edition is an online replica of the printed newspaper. It has many benefits, including archives for the previous 12 months, and the ability to search, save, print or email stories. If you would like to see a demonstration of our e-Edition, please go to e-edition.registerguard.com and click on the green Demo link. To access the e-Edition for your classroom, go to nie.registerguard.com and complete the order form. When filling out this order form, you will also be asked to confirm or submit your order for your print delivery. Once we receive your completed form, we will set up your account and email you instructions for accessing the e-Edition.

We have made plans to provide you with the number of (Wednesday – Friday) newspapers you were receiving in the previous term.
