BRING Recycling works under contract with Lane County to provide educational outreach to all Lane County schools. This service is provided free of charge.

BRING's Oregon licensed science teacher will come to your school and show your students how the stuff we use shapes the planet we share. We do this through assemblies, classroom presentations, and unit specific lessons tailored to the individual teacher's needs.

Our lessons are tied to the State Standards in social studies¹ and science² and to the Common Core Standards³. Applicable standards (^{1, 2, 3}) are printed on the back of this flyer.

The Three Rs:

- Students learn the importance of waste reduction and reuse
- Students understand that recycling is a last resort before the garbage can

Waste Reduction:

- Students identify and record the components of their waste stream
- Students organize the data collected into a usable plan for waste reduction
- Students re-examine their waste stream and chart progress towards waste reduction

Where Stuff Comes From:

- Students learn what natural resources are used to make the stuff of their everyday lives
- Students compare and contrast the natural resources to the finished goods

Vermicomposting:

- Students learn how vermicomposting can help with waste reduction goals
- Students learn about red wiggler worms
- Students examine the ecosystem of a worm bin

Paper Making:

- Students learn about paper recycling and its importance in waste reduction
- Students learn every step in the paper making process
- Students take home their art paper
