Come to the coast this summer to learn about how the Oregon Coast Education Program (OCEP) can support you and your students with best practices in coastal and marine education! Educators will take part in an in-depth experience to explore the practice of science in a diversity of coastal habitats in Newport and Charleston. Topics include coastal ecology and habitats, impacts and solutions including climate connections, working with data sets and making connections to your schools. Please choose from one of three workshops at your convenience. They include 3 nights of lodging, meals, and materials. *Current NAME members receive a discount on registration. Professional development units and continuing education credits will be available through Portland State University (cost not covered by OCEP).

Following the workshop, OCEP coordinators will continue to support you during implementation of your coastal education plan (CEP) during the school year and provide field experience funding. Teachers who opt to implement a CEP are required to complete an evaluation and will receive a stipend at the conclusion of the school year. During the 2014-15 school year, OCEP coordinators will meet with participants in their regions for small group work sessions to integrate teaching partners who were unable to attend a summer workshop.
