- 2) Students must be currently attending class in grades Kindergarten through Eighth.
- 3) The student must produce original artwork without assistance. One entry per child.
- 4) Submission size must be 8.5x11 preferably on white drawing paper.
- 5) May use crayon, pencil, color pencil, ink, pastels, paint, charcoal, etc...
- 6) Artwork must be submitted flat not folded.
- 7) Digital scans are accepted but must be 8.5x11, 600DPl or more in a TIFF or JPG file to *aarond@wasteconnections.com* or *radona@adlib.com*
- 8) Please include the attached submission form with each submission.
- 9) Original artwork submitted would not be able to be returned to the artist.
- 10) All entries must be received by October 31, 2015.
