Now Scheduling Field Trips to Lane County's Waste Management Facilities

Every year BRING takes hundreds of students on field trips of Lane County's waste handling facilities. This free service, provided by BRING and Lane County, gives the kids the opportunity to see where their waste goes and learn what they can do to reduce, reuse, and recycle.

Trip Format:

- BRING's Planet Improvement Center (4446 Franklin Blvd.)
 - o Gather
- Central Receiving Station
 - Find out how materials for recycling are processed
 - See where materials for reuse are collected
 - o Learn how garbage is concentrated for transportation to landfill
- Short Mountain Landfill
 - Follow the path of garbage
 - Experience sights and smells of our 540 acre landfill
- BRING's Planet Improvement Center
 - Understand how reuse can divert materials from landfill

Trip Length:

- 3 hours (can be shortened, as needed)
 - We can pay for your transportation!
 - Lane County Waste Management and EWEB can offer transportation reimbursements for Eugene School District, Bethel School District, and Rural School district trips.
