I hope you've all had a fabulous summer! We here at school are looking forward to seeing you soon and to having another great year at Howard Elementary School!t's been an eventful summer for Howard. Our old building came down in July and construction of our new playground and parking lot are now taking shape. The office opens Tuesday, August 23<sup>rd</sup>, though the parking lot may not be

We have several new staff members who I'd like to introduce. In the first grade wing, we'll have our very own preschool that being funded through the ODE Preschool Promise grant. Gretchen Baxter was hired as the preschool teacher. She previously taught Head Start at LCC and before that was a kindergarten teacher and a special education teacher. I think Howard may have the strongest instructional staff in all of 4J, so please welcome these fine new staff members as they join the Howard Elementary School family!
