My name is Anna Ingram, and I am the Administrative Program Assistant at the CTL Reading Clinic at the University of Oregon. I am writing to inform you of an opportunity for kindergartners, 1<sup>st</sup> grade, and 2<sup>nd</sup> grade students to receive free after school reading and/or math intervention services at the UO. Students who are performing below benchmark are encouraged to apply. Our reading services will focus on alphabetic principle/phonics and fluency instruction, so our program will be most beneficial for students performing below benchmark (strategic or intensive) in grades K-2.

Participating students will receive 50 minutes of direct instruction in reading and/or math using research-based intervention programs two times per week. Instruction will be provided in small groups, and will be delivered by undergraduate and graduate University of Oregon students. Services will take place at the HEDCO Education Building on the UO campus.

Space is limited and while we are open to K-2 students, our main focus will be on 1<sup>st</sup> graders. Any student in grades K-2 who is performing below benchmark in reading and/or math is eligible to apply, though priority will be given to 1<sup>st</sup> grade students. If more students apply than we have the capacity to serve, those students will be placed on a waiting list.

We hope that you may be able to help us get the word out to families of students who may benefit from these services. I have attached the application packet, which families will need to submit in order to apply for services. We are happy to provide your front office with printed copies of the application packet if you tell us how many copies you would like. At this time, we do not have Spanish applications as our translator is out of the office.
