The ODE District and School Effectiveness Team, in partnership with COSA is excited to announce our Summer Academies for 2017. This year, the academies will be held on July 31st through August 2nd, leading up to the COSA/ODE Summer Teaching, Learning and

Assessment Institute. This year's sessions will again be held in the Downtown Eugene Hilton, and will include 3 Strands:

- Strand 1 – How Math Teaching Matters for K-6 classrooms
- Strand 2 – Teaching the Reading Foundational Skills in your Standards-Based Primary Classroom, for K-2/3 classrooms
- Strand 3 – Intermediate Reading Instructional Strategies for the 3-8 Classroom

Additional information on the strands, can be found on the attached flyer. Registration costs for the conference are complimentary to all eligible schools (see priority listing below). In addition, COSA will be offering discounted rates for schools who want to stay and attend the remaining days of the Summer Teaching, Learning, and Assessment Institute. This year's speakers will reinforce the learning presented during the academies, and would be a great addition to your team's professional development.

Schools/districts are encouraged to sign up teams of educators, including teachers, instructional coaches, and principals. Participation in this event is by invitation only. Spaces are limited, and seats will be reserved on a first come first served basis, with the understanding that priority placement will be given in the following order:

- First Priority - School Improvement Grant Recipients
- Second Priority - Tier 3 Schools
- Third Priority - District Improvement Partnership Districts (who weren't already include in another priority grouping)
- Fourth Priority - RTI Schools (who weren't already included in another priority grouping)
- Fifth Priority - Any Tier 1 or 2 Schools (who weren't already include in another priority grouping)

We are asking that school/district teams pre-register using our google form – [Summer Academy Pre-Registration](#) . Once your pre-registration has been received, and your seats have been confirmed, your contact person will be notified, and your full registration can be completed with COSA.
