## PROGRAM TYPES

### EXHIBITS

From digital design to adventures in space, our exhibits travel the world to educate and excite audiences of all ages. Exhibits change regularly, so there’s always something new to explore. What will you discover?

### RESERVED LABS

Get some small group attention with a science educator in a private lab session perfect for grades K–12. Labs are \$75-\$100 for a 1-hour session, and accommodate 6–16 students. Topics include: chemistry, physics, biology and many more!

### PLANETARIUM SHOWS

See the sky differently with one of our 30–45 minute presentations covering a wide range of topics including extreme planet ecosystems, far-away galaxies, constellations, and black holes.

### THE EMPIRICAL THEATER

Watch and learn on a giant, 4-story tall screen with 3D educational films that cover fascinating topics like dinosaurs, oceanic environments and extreme weather.

### SUBMARINE TOURS

Prepare to dive through history and discover the inner workings of a submarine as you peer through a periscope, touch a torpedo, climb in a bunk in the crew’s quarters, and more. Sub tours are 50 minutes long.

### STAGE SHOWS

Bring a large class or entire grade to OMSI’s Auditorium for an hour-long assembly with science, surprises and a wow-factor. Min. 60 - Max 250 students.

### WHAT ELSE SHOULD YOU KNOW

- Museum Camp-Ins include dinner, snack and continental breakfast.
- We ask that all groups provide at least a 1:5 adult to child ratio. *Please plan for a minimum adult-to-student ratio of 1:5 for grades Pre-K-8.*
- Register at least 2 weeks in advance.
- The minimum capacity for a Museum Camp-in is 100 total participants, though this does not have to come from a single group. Final numbers will be gathered 30 days before the program date to determine whether the minimum has been met, if not the program will be canceled.
