- ✓ Financial Assistance such as work related transportation, clothes, tools, interview clothing
- ✓ **Career Advancement** such as exploring your skills and strengths, getting your GED, help keeping your current job, short-term training, job leads, supported work experience
- ✓ Building Job Search Skills such as help with applications, resume writing, interview practice and networking
- ✓ Home and Family such as community resources, childcare options, navigation services (for example, affordable housing and counseling), and budgeting.
