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We will have parent reports to send home with report cards! A huge thank you to Eric MacCionnaith and Oscar Loureiro for creating the parent reports. In order for elementary parent reports to go home with report cards, Easy CBM testing must be completed by **Thursday, January 30**. Please be sure all students have completed tests by Thursday and all data is entered by Friday, January 31. This will give Eric and Oscar Monday and Tuesday to get the reports completed and hopefully ready to print for schools on Wednesday. There is a lot of time that goes into creating the reports so they may not be ready to print until Thursday. The Easy CBM window is open longer to accommodate all grade levels across the district. The parent reports will be created for all elementary schools and should be sent home by each school.

Please be sure to communicate with staff about the change in the date to have testing completed by. It will also be a good idea to communicate with classroom teachers about the parent reports being sent home with report cards so they don't seal the envelopes before they have the reports.

Parent reports will be created for the new assessment pilot schools, McCornack and Charlemagne. It will not include the new assessment data but will have attendance, past Easy CBM data and State testing scores for 3rd-5th.
