I talked to the Hungerford's today and the short answer to all of this is that we will have to document any removal from teacher-led time as it is considered a "suspension" and will need to be documented as such and count towards our 10 days. We will type up more information and guidance and get it to you ASAP. I just know we have had issues already so wanted to share with you. A manifestation would be very interesting during these times, so my advice is if a student is being "habitually disruptive," I would look at moving them to packet work before we get to 10 days of removal. I would also make sure that if a student is removed for the lesson or office time to get support that the teachers are offering some other way for the student to get the information. Since most lessons are sent for students to watch when they can, this shouldn't be a problem, but I know I am not thinking of all scenarios.

More to come....just know this is coming up more often than I would have ever thought and we are only in day 2 of actual teaching....yikes!
