Hello Howard Staff...

We survived another week of remote learning! As teachers have started their ZOOM meetings with their classes, they are finding that it's challenging to juggle facilitating the meeting AND approving kids entering the meeting, watching out for zoom bombs, and inappropriate behavior by kids, etc. So we would like to assign someone to be their ZOOM Bouncer so they can focus on facilitating the meeting.

So these are the things I need to know:

CLASSROOM TEACHERS - Do you want a ZOOM Bouncer and when are your weekly ZOOM meetings scheduled for?

OTHER STAFF MEMBERS - Would you like to be a ZOOM Bouncer and which teachers/grade-levels did you work with the most?

I will take this information and match people up! I will do my best to have the pairings sent out by Monday so that teachers can connect with their "Bouncers" and share with them what they need in time to get started next week. In general, teachers will need "Bouncers" to let students into the meetings, NOT let other people into the meetings, and scroll the students for anything inappropriate to mute or bounce them out. You could even reach out to families (if the teacher wanted you to) that weren't on the ZOOM to see if they need help connecting.

PS TONS of staff members are ready to be your next Mystery Person on your ZOOM meeting. Essentially, they would make sure their name and face didn't pop up when they enter the meeting. Then the students would ask 20 yes or no questions to try and figure out who it was. The classroom teacher could answer the questions or the Mystery Person could type the answers into the chat for the older kids. So, just put it out there or ask someone individually!
