Soon it will be September and time to welcome back our teachers and many other staff. We are hard at work preparing to begin this one-of-a-kind school year.

Our 4J families will have three pathways for returning to learning this year:

- “Same School Hybrid” (beginning the school year online and returning to in-person learning when 4J schools begin on-site learning in a hybrid model)
- “Same School Online” (beginning the school year online and continuing online learning, connected with their regular school, when other students return to school on-site in the hybrid model)
- Eugene Online Academy (a separate 4J program with different curriculum, teachers and students).

To prepare for staffing each of these options, we have asked all families to respond with their preferred choice. A critical piece of information families need in considering their options is what the school day will look like.

Grade-level teams of teachers, specialists and administrators have worked over the summer to develop daily learning schedules. We are sharing these draft schedules now for parents' information, although bargaining is ongoing with EEA about certain details.

We wanted our 4J staff to have the first look. Schedule information will be [posted on the district website at this link](#), and will be shared in communications to families soon.
