Stacy,

We met with all of the Head Custodians last week to review what is the same and what is changing, in terms of COVID protocols for this school year. I'll summarize those changes to disinfecting requirements below:

- 1) Day Custodians (regardless of grade level) no longer have the "on the hour" disinfecting requirements for restrooms and other high traffic touch points.
- 2) Evening Custodians at Elementary Schools - nightly electrostatic disinfecting of all common touch-points (same as last year), except individual student desks/chairs do not need to be sprayed nightly. Small group instruction tables in the back of classrooms or in hallways, as well as resource rooms (CLC's, Title Rooms, etc.) DO NEED to be sprayed nightly.
- 3) Evening Custodians at Middle Schools/High Schools - nightly electrostatic disinfecting nightly does include individual student desks/chairs, weight rooms, etc.
- 4) Cafeteria tables will be sanitized with the Food Services provided sanitizer between meal periods. The cafeteria tables need to be disinfected nightly with the electrostatic sprayers and the Bioesque (but not between meal services).

I believe those are the most significant changes in terms of what surfaces (and how often) need to be disinfected during this school-year, as of this point in time.
