Students can run a variety of activities under your supervision and assist you in a variety of other ways. You can host 1 or 2 students.



Host Organization Qualifications

- Designate a supervisor who can help provide a positive and inclusive learning environment
- Experienced educational professional serve as supervisor
- Volunteer opportunities must be supervised.
- Field experiences and responsibilities may vary.
- Volunteers assist with children, youth, or families activities on site or online.

Benefits of Hosting an EdF student:

- Consistent and eager helpers
- Academic support to individuals or small groups, academic enrichment, physical education, art education, nature and STEM activities, multilingual support and other activities
- Understanding of the social and cultural dimensions of education
