

Current Calls Coming In - COVID (updated Jan 5, 2022)

- 1) Guardian calls and reports a **student has tested positive:**
 - a) **Ask:** When/where did you test?
 - b) **Ask:** When did symptoms begin?
 - c) **Ask:** How is the student doing (showing care)?
 - d) **Ask:** Have siblings or household members been tested?
 - e) **Tell:** Stay home and quarantine. Quarantine length is now FIVE days.
 - f) **Tell:** A nurse will give you a call to give you a return date.
 - g) **Complete:** [COVID reporting form](#).

- 2) Guardian calls and reports a **student is a close contact:**
 - a) **Ask:** When were they exposed?
 - b) **Ask:** Where were they exposed?
 - c) **Ask:** Is the student fully vaccinated?
 - d) **Ask:** Do they have symptoms of COVID (really, any cold symptoms).
 - e) **Tell:** If vaccinated and no symptoms, no need to quarantine (monitor symptoms).
 - f) **Tell:** If unvaccinated and no symptoms, quarantine FIVE days.
 - g) **Complete:** [COVID reporting form](#).

- 3) Guardian calls in and reports a **student is feeling sick:**
 - a) **Ask:** What are the symptoms?
 - i) Cold symptoms: runny nose, throat, headache
 - 1) **Tell:** Keep home until well, please consider a COVID test as these symptoms are present with the Omicron variant.
 - ii) Primary COVID symptoms: cough, fever >100.3, shortness of breath, loss of taste/smell
 - 1) **Ask:** When did they start feeling sick?
 - 2) **Tell:** If cold symptoms, stay home until feeling well (recommend a COVID test).
 - 3) **Tell:** If COVID symptoms, stay home and quarantine, recommend a test. **TEN** day quarantine.
