Good morning team,

The **air quality index** is **good** right now and we are monitoring if something change while our students are at school today.

Air Quality Index (AQI) Values	Levels of Health Concern	Colors
<i>When the AQI is in this range:</i>	<i>..air quality conditions are:</i>	<i>...as symbolized by this color:</i>
0-50	Good	Green
51-100	Moderate	Yellow
101-150	Unhealthy for Sensitive Groups	Orange
151 to 200	Unhealthy	Red
201 to 300	Very Unhealthy	Purple
301 to 500	Hazardous	Maroon

As a reminder, if we get into the range considered **"Unhealthy for Sensitive Groups"** with the AQI between 101-150 be mindful of certain students that may need to remain inside.

We hope that during the school day we will not get into **"Unhealthy,"** with the AQI just over 150+. However, if we do, please keep outdoor activities to a minimum. **Students may eat outside, and recess may be held outside, but activity should be limited—no high-exertion activities like running games.**
