Good morning team,

The air quality index is **good** right now and we are monitoring if something change while our students are at school today.

Air Quality Index (AQI) Values	Levels of Health Concern	Colors
When the AQI is in this range:	air quality conditions are:	as symbolized by this color:
0-50	Good	Green
51-100	Moderate	Yellow
101-150	Unhealthy for Sensitive Groups	Orange
151 to 200	Unhealthy	Red
201 to 300	Very Unhealthy	Purple
301 to 500	Hazardous	Maroon

As a reminder, if we get into the range considered **"Unhealthy for Sensitive Groups"** with the AQI between 101-150 be mindful of certain students that may need to remain inside.

We hope that during the school day we will not get into "**Unhealthy**," with the AQI just over 150+. However, if we do, please keep outdoor activities to a minimum. **Students may eat outside, and recess may be held outside, but** <u>activity</u> should be limited—no <u>high-exertion</u> activities like running games.
