At the Red Cross, we are excited for a new school year and a chance to provide our youth curriculum for students.

We are very appreciative to have reached students since our inception of the various programs.

Since 2013, The Pillowcase Project has reached more than 1 million students across the country and on U.S. military bases abroad.

Last year, post-pandemic, we successfully reintroduced the Red Cross youth program to schools throughout Oregon and taught 4,135 students throughout the state.

The Red Cross is available for this school year with our free one-hour curriculum and is available in Spanish and English

Our youth preparedness is available for three grades.

- Prepare with Pedro – K-2nd grade
- Pillowcase Project – 3rd-5th grade
- Be Red Cross Ready – 6th - High School

Attached is a flyer that explains each program in more detail.

These free 60-minute presentations teach children about emergencies that may happen in our region, how to cope with stressful situations, and how to be prepared in advance. We provide take-home materials for the family and workbooks with activities. We generally teach about Wildfires and Home Fire preparedness. We do have additional topics based on your school's immediate disaster issues, such as flooding and Tsunami
