The Oregon Health Authority has received an update from the FDA regarding the iHealth Self-Test Expiry Extension. Please find the extension notice here, which will provide the most current expiration date for the iHealth tests your school may have in supply. With this recent update, the iHealth tests are viable to use in symptomatic and exposure testing through March 2023 or April 2023, depending on the lot number associated with your school's testing kits.

Please note: the iHealth tests are to be used to support symptomatic and exposure testing in K-12 students and staff in schools registered in OHA's K-12 Diagnostic Testing program for the 2022-2023 School Year, when BinaxNOW tests are not readily available. Please ensure these tests are used in accordance with the protocols listed in the <u>guidance</u> and that they are not distributed to individuals or groups not enrolled in the diagnostic testing program.
