Good morning,

For your reference only, we have made changes in accommodations for our volunteers with religious and/or medical exceptions.

We will no longer require masking as an accommodation for volunteers who have a religious exception on file with the district. While (OAR) 333-019-1030 requires teachers, school staff and volunteers to be vaccinated or have an approved religious or medical exception on file, volunteers with approved exceptions have been required to mask, but will no longer be required to do so. Volunteers will be required to screen for symptoms and stay home when sick. All new volunteers who are not vaccinated must still apply for an exception, and we must document and retain their request and our approval on file. New accommodations for volunteers with approved exceptions are as follows:

- 1. Screen for symptoms on a daily basis
  - If you are actively sick with fever (above 100.1 degrees Fahrenheit), vomit, or diarrhea, then you must not report to volunteer.
- 2. Practice regular hand hygiene (wash hands or use hand sanitizer)
- 3. It is suggested, but not required, that you wear a mask in large group settings.
- Follow any additional current or future protocols or procedures as required by Oregon Health Authority, Oregon Department of Education, Lane County Public Health, or Eugene School District 4J.
