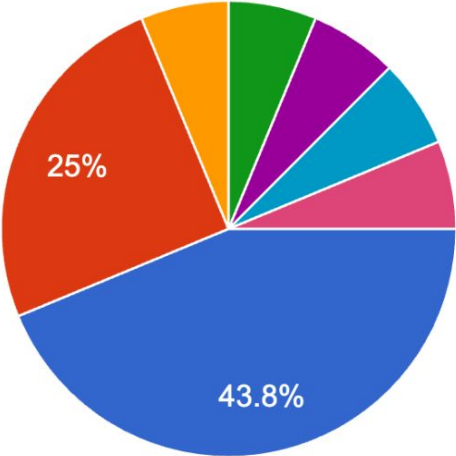

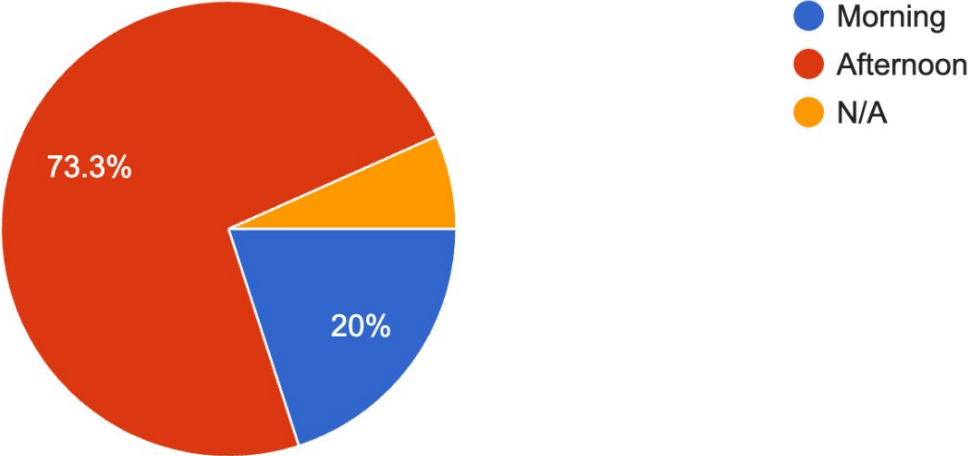

- I have no preference on this as it doesn't really affect me.

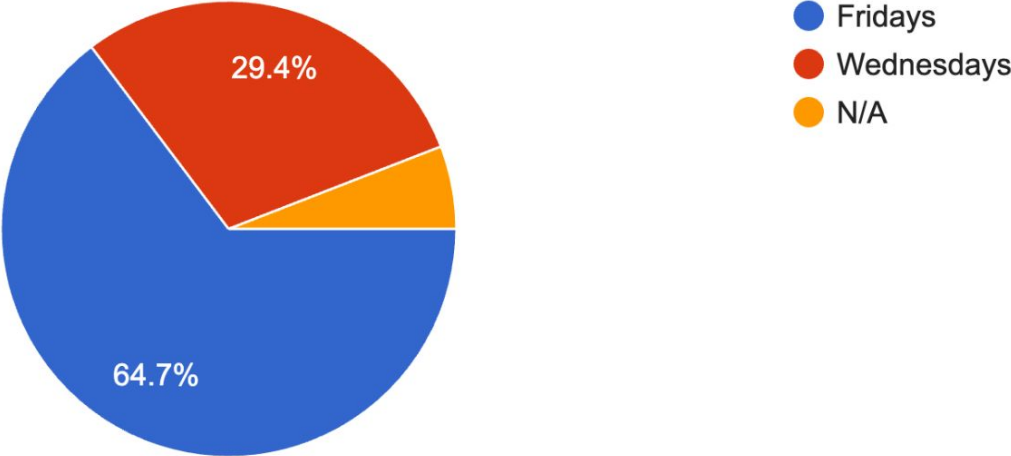
For assembly times, would you prefer the open slot on the PE/Music/Library schedule be in the morning or afternoon?

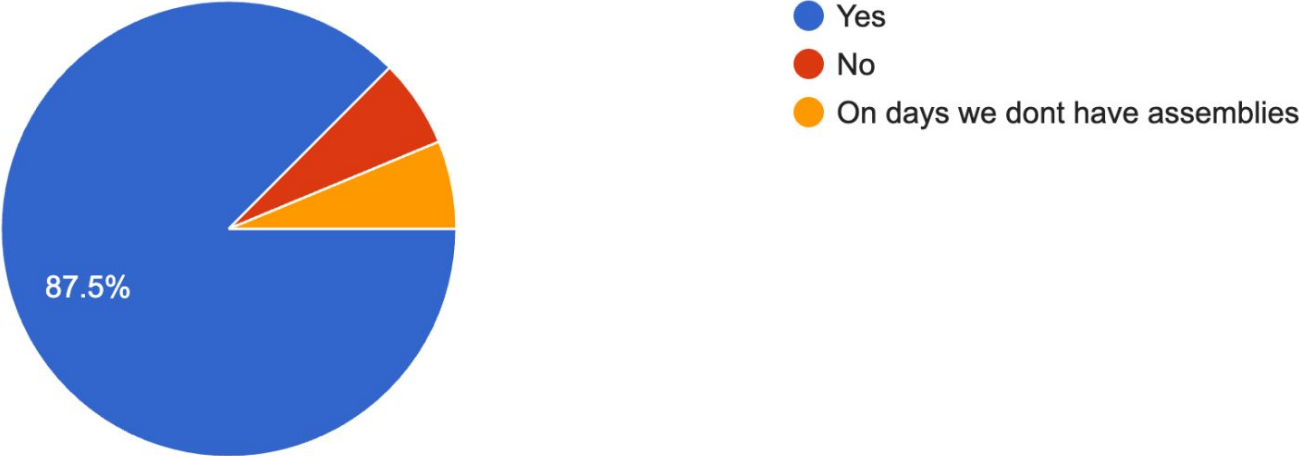
For assembly dates, would you prefer Fridays or Wednesdays (since we don't have Title groups that day).

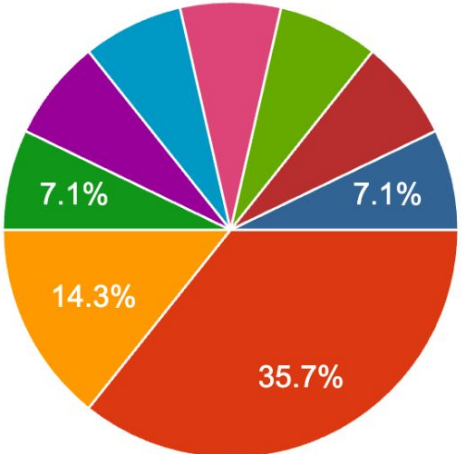
Would you be in favor of scheduling a PBIS Friday? In the past, Holt used to do these in the afternoon as a periodic reward.

Not that we can make this happen for everyone, but would you prefer Tier 3 times to be before or after core reading and math times?

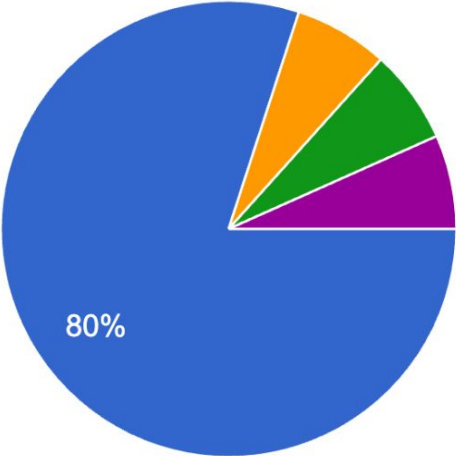
