HOW TO PRESENT A QUESTION

- 1. Write the problem neatly on the whiteboard.
- 2. Face the group members.
- 3. Read the question out loud to the group.
- 4. Explain any prior knowledge and what you already understand about the question.
- Explain what strategies you used in attempting to answer the question.
- 6. Indicate to your group exactly where you became confused as you worked to answer this question.
