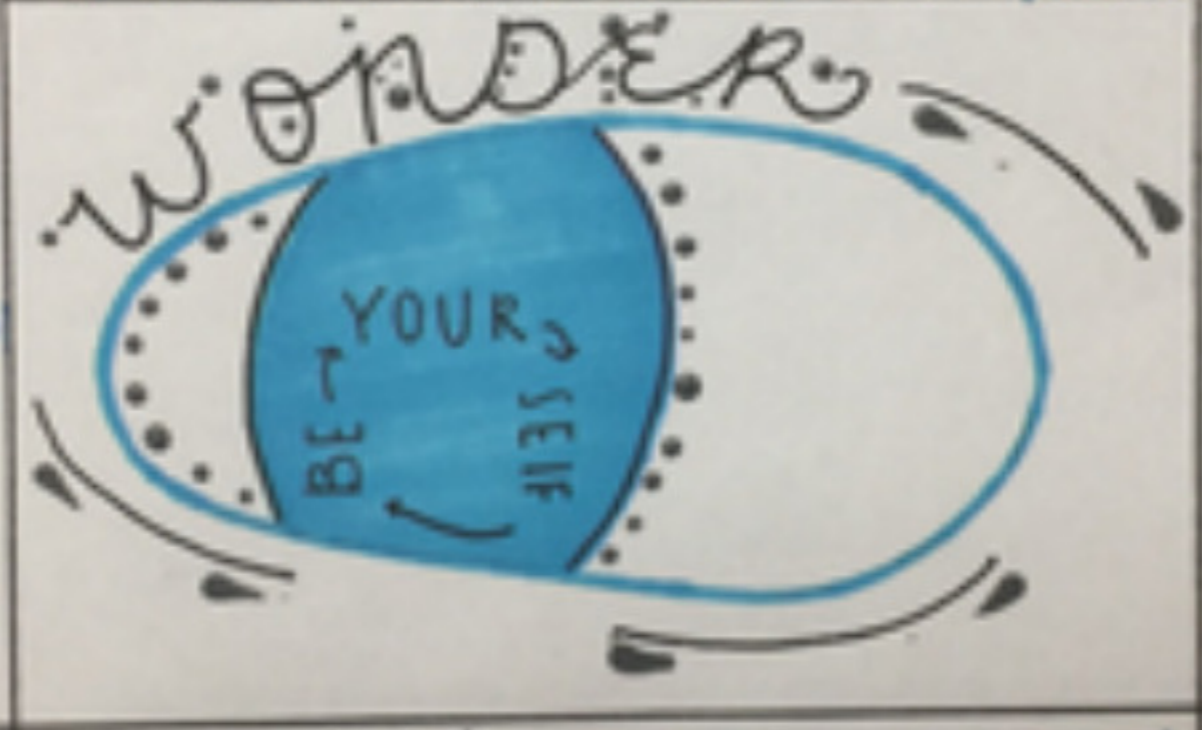
- Auggie is the main character in **WONDER**. He is quite different than any other kids.

The Odyssey: Epic Hero

"Possesses **SUPERHUMAN** strength, craftiness, and confidence"

Odysseus was very strong and was able to stab the Cyclops in the eye. He was smart enough too to not kill the Cyclops so they could escape.



Odysseus was using his craftiness by disguising as an old man instead of revealing himself and getting killed by all the suitors.



Odysseus acted like an epic hero when he made sure all his crew was safe from the Sirens. He made sure that he listened to Circe's warning. I think it represents his trust in others.

"We beached there, and I told the crew to stand by and keep watch over the ship; as for myself I took my 12 best fighters and went ashore" (pg. 276)

"Eurylochus tells Odysseus what has happened and begs him to sail away from Circe's island against this advice, however, Odysseus rushes to save his men from the enchantress" (pg. 287)

"You dared bid for my wife while I was still alive. Contempt was all you had for the gods who rule wide heaven, contempt for what men say of you here after. Your last hour has come." (pg. 409)
