Golden vs. Platinum Rule Examples for Slide #11:

Visiting a new place of worship.

- Golden Rule: Wearing (or not wearing) a head covering since it is (or isn't) expected in your house of worship.
- Platinum Rule: Ask ahead of time if a head covering is expected in the place you will visit.

Your friend is vegan or gluten free.

- Golden Rule: You have a party and order pepperoni pizza because lots of people like it.
- Platinum Rule: Ask your friend if there's a type of pizza they can eat, or order something else altogether so your friend can enjoy it.

Throwing a birthday party for someone who is shy and doesn't like crowds.

- Golden Rule: There is loud music and lots of people because that's what your last birthday was like and it was great!
- Platinum Rule: Doing something more low key or with less people involved.

Greeting someone from another culture for the first time

- Golden Rule: Shake their hand immediately because that's what you've been taught
- Platinum Rule: Wait to see how they want to interact with you. It may be a bow, or a hug!

The Golden Rule is sometimes (not always) selfish.
