Scene 1: (TEXT) Preparing for OAKS Testing

Scene 2: (TEXT) The Oregon Assessment of Knowledge and skills is the program for Oregon's standardized state testing.

Scene 3: (BACKGROUND VIDEO)

Camera Angle - Eye Level

Setting - Room 212

Action - Student logs onto OAKS site

Description- Camera shows a students computer screen, where they are logging onto OAKS site and taking a practice test.

(TEXT) In order to perform optimally on the tests, you need to prepare

Scene 4: (VIDEO)

Camera Angle - Eye Level

Setting - Classroom

Action - Teacher says what they think are the most important things while preparing for state testing.

Description - Camera shows a teacher, who is being asked what they think students should do in order to prepare for OAKS testing.

Scene 5: (BACKGROUND VIDEO)

Camera Angle - Pan

Setting - Library, sofa

Action - Student sleeps

Description - Camera shows a student sleeping on the "bed"

(TEXT) Students should get plenty of sleep the night before OAKS testing.

Scene 6: (BACKGROUND VIDEO)

Camera Angle - Eye Level

Setting - Library, sofa

Action - Student wakes up refreshed and ready

Description - Camera shows student waking up after a good night's sleep, ready for testing!

(TEXT) Getting 8 or more hours of sleep helps the brain function during a test, and you can recall information easier.

Scene 7: (BACKGROUND VIDEO)

Camera Angle - Eye Level

Setting - Cafeteria/courtyard

Action - Student eats healthy meal

Description - Camera shows a student eating a healthy meal before testing

(TEXT) Eating a good breakfast is important in order to give an optimal performance on a test.

Scene 8: (BACKGROUND VIDEO)

Camera Angle - Tilt

Setting - Classroom

Action - Student takes practice test

Description - Camera shows a student taking an OAKS practice test. They are prepared and ready.

Scene 9: (SCROLLING TEXT) It is important that before a test you: Get a good night's sleep, eat well, prepare by taking practice tests, know how to use different tools on OAKS tests, know the standards that you will be graded by, ask a teacher if you have questions before the test, review material learned from the past year, if you have stress then learn ways to cope with it, think positively, do your best!

Scene 10: (VIDEO)

Camera Angle - Dolly

Setting - Classroom

Action - Student receives great test score

Description - Camera shows student who has received a great OAKS test score!

Scene 11: (TEXT) If you work hard and prepare by following these guidelines, you will ace the OAKS assessments!
