





Dori V.



Dori Vaughn came to Jamestown in 1609 on the Third Supply Mission when she was 17 years old. She was an indentured servant to Samuel Percy, but also became his fiancée a week before they departed. There were seven ships in total; Dori and Samuel went on the ship called The Diamond. Along the way Samuel got sick and died a week before his 30<sup>th</sup> birthday. Dori arrived in Jamestown right before a period called the starving time. As John Smith wrote in The General History of Virginia, "These were the most miserable, poor creatures. These people survived for the most part by eating roots, herbs, acorns, walnuts, berries, now and then a little fish...". She was a better cook than most of the men and survived because of how resourceful she was. Smith wrote, "But the fault was our own for our lack of... ability to govern ourselves." This is why she returned to England after some time. She later married and ran a bakery.

Shamond  
O'Roy



This Gunner's name is Shamond O'Roy. He was a Gunner who was hired by London Company to aid and assist the colony in defense. He worked as a Guard on the Perimeter. He got into several engagements with the Native Powhatan Confederacy with whom relations had turned sour. John Smith was exploring him. He got in trouble and got captured at one point with Captain Smith.



Lieutenant Nopp arrived in Jamestown as a mercenary who was hired by the London Company to protect the Colony of Jamestown, and to protect John Smith once they arrived. When Captain John Smith was exploring, Lt. Nopp was often with him navigating the rivers. Lt. Nopp was with John Smith when, "they brought him [Smith] to Mefonocomoco". Eventually, Nopp decided to leave the New World, and return to England to work at a horse stable for the rest of her life.



Kivar Parthasarathy arrived at Jamestown on the Discovery along with Captain John Smith. He was a metalsmith and worked alongside others to create weapons, tools, and other important things for the colony. He also helped navigate the waterways, and was captured by Powhatan along with John Smith, but was released as stated by John Smith's "True Relation", stating that there was "one to accompany me". He then made a small fortune and died of unknown causes at age 42.
