The Arts Alive production team is seeking students for volunteer hours for production internships. Here is a description of the event and a list of possible tasks needed:

Global Cultural Commons presents ArtsAlive 2024 "Levity", an evening of dance, music, and art at the Farmer's Market Pavilion in Downtown Eugene. Our full evening features local dancers, musicians, visual artists and more, demonstrating their art, collaborating with one another, and engaging the public to learn and create, with the evening culminating in a fun open public dance party. **ArtsAlive** is a FREE public event that uses art to bring people together - to unite people across experience and identity that creates accessible experiences for individuals new to dance and movement, followed by the first year of the Arts Projection on the wall of the Farmer's Market Pavilion, along with the performance of another local band. ArtsAlive 2024 is the proud recipient of the Eugene Downtown Program Fund Award in 2024. ArtsAlive is in its 8th year, bringing dance, music, and art to the public. This year our exciting event will take place at the Farmer's Market Pavilion (8th and Park St.) from 6pm-10pm on June 14th. We are community members, business owners, and artists, and we offer internship opportunities for high school students to learn hands-on experience with event production. This year's theme is **Levity** ~ The works appearing in this year's line-up will explore this theme in various expressions, including works of homage and self-expression. ArtsAlive brings dance and live music, an interdisciplinary program, to the public for free.

Volunteer hours for production internship are needed in the following areas:

- Assist in setup of sound system (following sound tech instruction).
- Assist in setup and running of video recording (Cell Phone App with tripod will be supplied).
- Help unload the dance floor panels (light weight units) and assemble inside Farmers Market Pavillion.
- Assist with photographic documentation.
- Help with setup and running of art projection (system will be supplied for PC fed video on projectors) from 8 till 10 pm outside front of Farmers Market Pavillion.
- Publicity and marketing assistance working with our event organizer.(Using google forms, google sheets, basic budget tracking, and writing email templates
