





ENTERING GLACIER NATIONAL PARK



We had just entered Glacier National Park and we see a mountain with snow on it. We were very exited to see what we were going to find next.






We continue on the road when we see a waterfall out the window along the windy section of our drive.




After we see a waterfall we see a huge lake with mountains all around it. The clouds were swirled around the tips of the mountains. We all took pictures it was so cool.






We were almost to the top of the mountain when we saw this valley with mountains all around with some clouds above them it looked so cool when we finally reached the top we saw the most amazing sight.
