## **Laboratory Safety Agreement**

- 7. Report any accident or injury to the instructor immediately, even if it seems minor.
- 8. Place broken glass in designated containers, never in the regular trash can.
- 9. When using razor blades or utility knives, always cut away from you and your lab partner.
- 10. When your lab is complete, put away all materials to their proper places and clean up your work area.
- 11. Use common sense, think before you act.
