The Lorax tells the story of a once thriving imaginary ecosystem in which Truffula Trees, Brown Bar-ba-loots, Humming-Fish, and Swanee-Swans all lived harmoniously. That is until the Once-ler came to the area and began to reap the benefits of the environmental resources. As you watch this movie, you should consider the following questions:

- 1. Do you think it is possible to use so much of a resource that no more will be available?
- 2. Can use or overuse of another species cause that species to become extinct?
- 3. Is it possible to use resources wisely in a way that there will always be some left for the future?

Your assignment will be to write a <u>3 paragraph</u> essay formatted as follows: Paragraph 1:

 Describe the ecosystem within *The Lorax* using the terms: species, population, community, ecosystem, producer, consumer, keystone species, biotic factor, abiotic factor

Paragraph 2:

 Describe the changes that took place within the ecosystem when the Once-ler began using the resources within the ecosystem using the terms: industrial growth, resources, sustainability, pollution, and human impact

Paragraph 3:

• Discuss what you think about the motivation of both the Once-ler and The Lorax and *defend your ideas with evidence!!!*

Your essay will be graded based on the following criteria:

1. Your essay is 3 paragraphs, typed, double spaced, uses proper grammar, punctuation, and spelling is correct

5 points

2. Your essay accurately describes the ecosystem portrayed in *The Lorax*, accurately describes the changes that took place, and includes **ALL** terms mentioned above

15 points

3. You provide in your essay reasonable motivations for the actions of the Onceler and The Lorax, and *use evidence to justify your thoughts and ideas*
