Linear Perspective

*NEED: Piece of Cardstock, Ruler, colored Pencils

1) Using a Ruler, draw 5 shapes on your piece of cardstock. Be neat and take your time.

2) Once you have drawn your shapes, you must decide where your perspective point will be. Once you decide, make the point.

3) Using a ruler draw lines from your perspective point to the corners of any squares or triangles, or the edge of circles. Be sure that you are not drawing over the top of other shapes or the perspective lines to another shape. Tip: start with the shapes nearest your perspective point

4) When you are finished drawing your lines, then draw scenes or pictures in each of your shapes and color the rest of your project.

**Neatness Counts
