

8 Boxes Elements of Art

- 1) HUE: Using Primary Hues (red, yellow, blue), color Box #1.
- 2) Use light and dark values of a color to fill Box #2.
- 3) Use bright and dull intensities of colored pencils, to color in #3.
- 4) Using pencil, go over the lines in Box #4, making some straight, some curved, try pressing down to give thicker or darker effect.
- 5) Using pencil, crayons, colored pencils or markers, create three different textures in Box #5.
- 6) Using the markers, draw outlines around shapes in box #6. Fill in some of the shapes with the markers, leave others white.
- 7) Use pencil to add a new shape that overlaps the existing shapes in Box #7 to show space. Add to this feeling of space by using colored pencil to color this shape in a bright hue. Color the other shapes in dull hues.
- 8) Using the pencil, shade the shapes in Box #8 little by little. Try to make these shapes look like rounded, three-dimensional forms.
