### ***Science Fiction***

Anderson, R. J.- ***Ultraviolet***

Mature Content

Almost seventeen-year-old Alison, who has synesthesia, finds herself in a psychiatric facility accused of killing a classmate whose body cannot be found.

Asher, Jay and Mackler, Carolyn - ***Future of Us***

Receiving her first computer and an America Online CD-ROM in 1996, student Emma and her best friend, Josh, log on and discover themselves on Facebook, 15 years in the future, and learn astonishing things about their adult selves. Co-written by the award-winning author of *Tangled* and the best-selling author of *Thirteen Reasons Why*.

Brooks, Kevin - ***iBoy***

Mature Content

Sixteen-year-old Tom Harvey was an ordinary Londoner until an attack that caused fragments of an iPhone to be embedded in his brain, giving him incredible knowledge and power, but using that power against the gang that attacked him and a friend could have deadly consequences.

Condie, Allyson Braithwaite – ***Matched*** (YRCA 2013)

Cassia has always trusted the Society to make the right choices for her, so when Xander appears on-screen at her Matching ceremony, Cassia knows he is her ideal mate -- until Ky Markham's face appears for an instant before the screen fades to black.

Cross, Julie - ***Tempest***

A first installment in a trilogy by a debut author follows the adventures of teen Jackson Meyer, whose ability to travel through time without disrupting the space-time continuum is thrown into turmoil when his girlfriend is accidentally killed and Jackson winds up stuck two years in the past.

Dashner, James - ***Kill Order***

A prequel to the best-selling *Maze Order* Trilogy traces the fateful period after the earth is decimated by catastrophic solar flares and reveals the stories behind the formation of WICKED, the construction of the Glade and Thomas' entry into the Maze.

Evans, Richard Paul - ***Michael Vey : The Prisoner of Cell 25***

Michael Vey, a fourteen-year old who has Tourette's syndrome and special electric powers, finds there are others like him, and must rely on his powers to save himself and the others from a diabolical group seeking to control them.

***- Rise of the Elgen***

A sequel to *Michael Vey* finds Michael, Taylor and tecno-genius Ostin forming an alliance meant to protect them from the Order of Elgen, who has kidnapped Michael's mother as part of a plot to destroy children with supernatural powers.

Grant, Michael - ***Fear: A Gone Novel***

Determined to survive in spite of plague, hunger and betrayals, the ravaged children of Perdido Beach work together to forge a tenuous new existence where the Darkness is becoming an ultimate threat.

Haddix, Margaret Peterson - ***Caught***

When Jonah and Katherine travel to early 1900s Switzerland and Serbia to return Albert Einstein's daughter, Lieserl, to history, her mother Mileva grasps entirely too much about time travel and has no intention of letting her daughter go.

Harrison, Michelle - **13 Treasures**

Bedeveled by evil fairies that only she can see, thirteen-year-old Tanya is sent to stay with her cold and distant grandmother at Elveden Manor, where she and the caretaker's son solve a disturbing mystery that leads them to the discovery that Tanya's life is in danger.

Hirsch, Jeff - **Eleventh Plague**

Twenty years after the start of the war that caused the Collapse, fifteen-year-old Stephen, his father, and grandfather travel post-Collapse America scavenging, but when his grandfather dies and his father decides to risk everything to save the lives of two strangers, Stephen's life is turned upside down.

Lu, Marie - **Legend**

Raised in an elite military family in a war-torn nation that was once the Western United States, 15-year-old June embarks on a revelatory cat-and-mouse manhunt for criminal youth Day, who is declared a prime suspect in the murder of June's brother.

Mullin, Mike - **Ashfall**

After the eruption of the Yellowstone supervolcano destroys his city and its surroundings, fifteen-year-old Alex must journey from Cedar Falls, Iowa, to Illinois to find his parents and sister, trying to survive in a transformed landscape and a new society in which all the old rules of living have vanished.

- **Ashen Winter**

More than six months after the eruption of the Yellowstone supervolcano, Alex and Darla retrace their steps to Iowa hoping to find Alex's parents and bring them to the tenuous safety of Illinois, but the journey is ever more perilous as the remaining communities fight to the death for food and power.

O'Brien, Caragh M.- **Birthmarked**

When her midwife mother is forcibly taken away by the very people she serves, sixteen-year-old Gaia Stone starts to question the role of the Enclave and whether it deserves the loyalty her family has so faithfully given.

- **Prized**

The leadership in Sylum is threatened by Gaia and attempts to control her by systematically separating her from everyone she loves, including her infant sister and boyfriend Leon. (Sequel to *Birthmarked*)

Oliver, Lauren - **Pandemonium**

Mature Content

After falling in love, Lena and Alex flee their society where love is outlawed and everyone must receive "the cure"--an operation that makes them immune to love--but Lena alone manages to find her way to a community of resistance fighters.

Patterson, James; Rust, Ned - **Game Over (Daniel X Book 4)**

In Tokyo, fifteen-year-old Daniel X faces two of the most dangerous aliens on the planet, who are plotting to use video games to control children and turn them into an army of doom.

Reeve, Philip - **Scrivener's Moon (Fever Crumb #3)**

Revis, Beth - **Across the Universe**

Mature Content

Amy joins her parents as frozen cargo aboard the vast spaceship Godspeed and expects to awaken on a new planet three hundred years in the future, but her frozen slumber abruptly ends when someone on board the ship tries to murder her.

Vande Velde, Vivian - ***Deadly Pink*** (A companion to *Heir Apparent* and *User Unfriendly*)

Fourteen-year-old Grace must find a way to get her older sister out of a princess-filled virtual reality RPG (role playing game)--before it is too late.

Young, Moira - ***Blood Red Road***

Mature Content

In a distant future, Lugh is kidnapped, and while his twin sister Saba and nine-year-old Emmi are trailing him across bleak Sandsea they are captured, too, and taken to brutal Hopetown, where Saba is forced to be a cage fighter.

Wells, Dan - ***Partials***

Mature Content

In a post-apocalyptic eastern seaboard ravaged by disease and war with a manmade race of people called Partials, the chance at a future rests in the hands of Kira Walker, a sixteen-year-old medic in training.

Wells, Robison - ***Variant***

After years in foster homes, seventeen-year-old Benson Fisher applies to New Mexico's Maxfield Academy in hopes of securing a brighter future, but instead he finds that the school is a prison and no one is what he or she seems.

Zevin, Gabrielle - ***All These Things I've Done***

In a future where chocolate and caffeine are contraband, cellphone use is illegal, and water and paper are rationed, Anya Balanchine finds herself thrust into the spotlight as heir apparent to an important New York City crime family.
