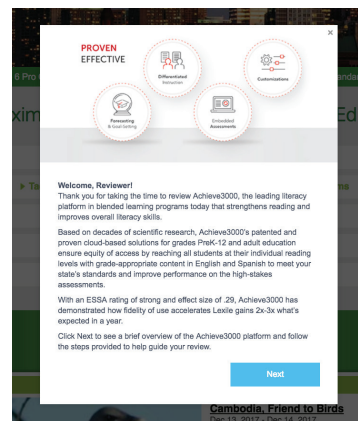

Follow the on-screen instructions for a self-guided tour!

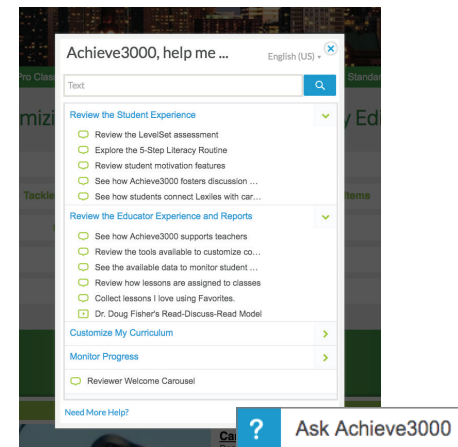
This tour will help you choose the **username** and **password** for the Achieve3000 solution and user type you'd like to review. We recommend beginning by choosing a **teacher login**, as you will be able to review both the **student and teacher experience** from this perspective as well as have access to a series of self-guided tours in the Teacher Edition.

Once logged in with a teacher review account, you will be **guided** through an **overview of the Achieve3000 platform**, followed by the option of how you'd like to continue your review.



You can choose the **Quick Review** (a 10- to 15-minute guided tour) or the **Extended Review** (a 20- to 25-minute guided tour), or **explore on your own**. Exit the guided review at any time to explore a feature in more depth or switch to the option to explore on your own.

If you choose to **explore on your own**, you will still have access to all of the same guided tours through the **Ask Achieve3000 menu** at the bottom-right of your screen.
