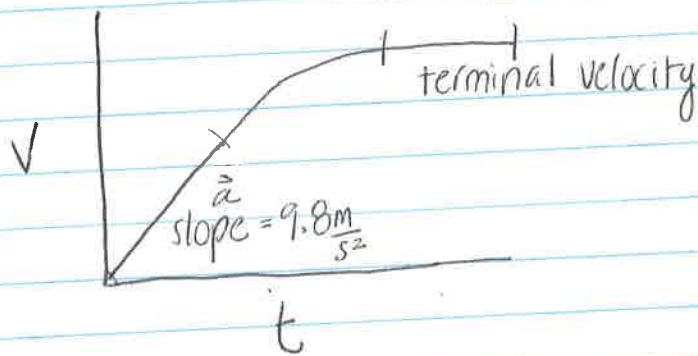
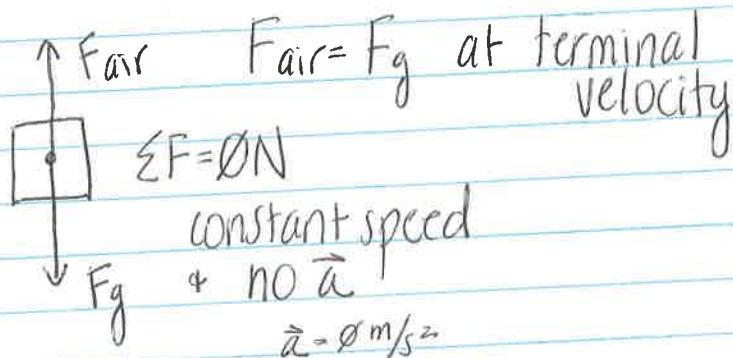


Terminal Velocity

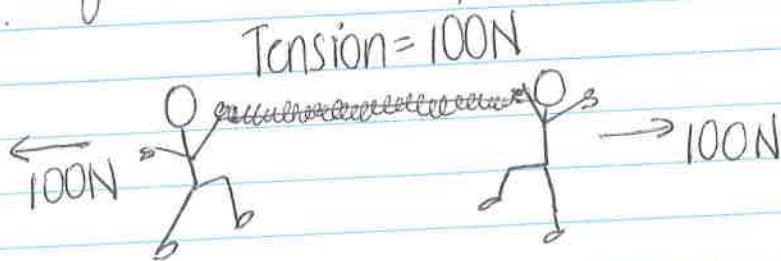
Terminal Velocity Terminal velocity is the maximum velocity of falling object.

At terminal velocity, the force of gravity is equal in magnitude to the force of drag (air resistance)



Tension

The pulling force carried by a rope is called tension.



The tension is not additive.
