

Sheldon Key Club Medallion Criteria (08/16/2016)

Purpose: To celebrate and honor committed service and leadership to the club and to the community.

Award: Medallions will be given to any member who qualifies according to the criteria below, as confirmed by the advisers.

Medallions will be awarded to members during the first club meeting in May.

The medalions will be paid for with money from the admin account.

Advisers will announce or remind students about the Medallion the first of every trimester.

Orders: The Qualified members to receive the Medallion will be determined on April 1st every year and then ordered soon after.

Criteria: To earn a medallion, all of the following four criteria must be met:

1. A member must be a fully registered (and paid) member of the club for 5 trimesters, two of which are the first two trimesters of their Grade 12 year.
2. Club meeting attendance must be at least 80% or higher for each of the five trimesters.
3. A minimum of 2 club sponsored service projects must be completed during each of the five trimesters.
4. In addition, either (a) or (b) must be met:
 - (a) The member must make one or more additional contributions to the club at some point. Ideas might include:
 - *Be a club officer*
 - *Be a representative*
 - *Lead a service project (anyone can lead a project, not just the officers)*
 - *Lead an activity at a club meeting*
 - *Attend a Key Leader training in October*
 - *Attend a Northwest District Convention (as a grade 9, 10 or 11 student)*
 - *Other ideas are possible (individuals can make a proposal to the advisers)*
 - (b) Or the member must show a longer, sustained, committment to service. Specifially, they must be a fully registered (and paid) member of the club for three years, including the first two trimesters of their senior year.
