



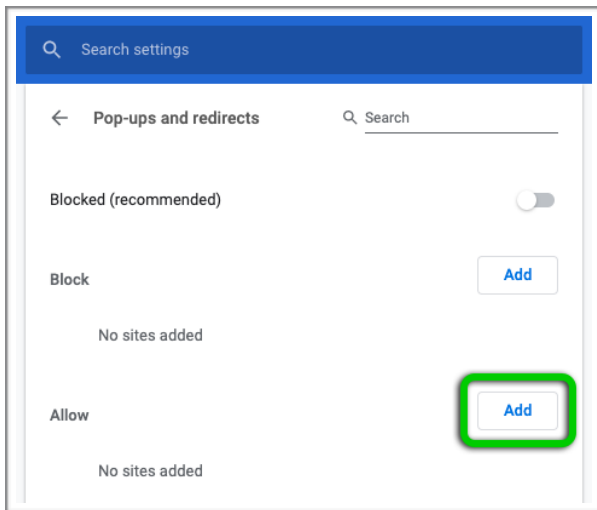
Web Browser Pop-ups

Getting Started

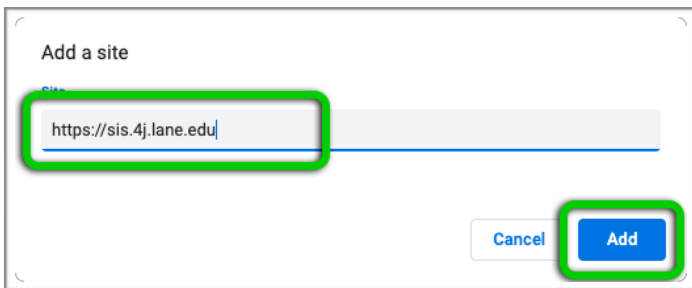
This document shows how to configure Chrome, Firefox, and Safari to allow website pop-ups.

Part 1: Chrome

1. Launch Chrome, enter the following address into the address bar, and press Enter/Return:
<chrome://settings/content/popups>
2. The “Pop-ups and redirects” configuration page appears.
3. Under the “Allow” section, click the “Add” button:



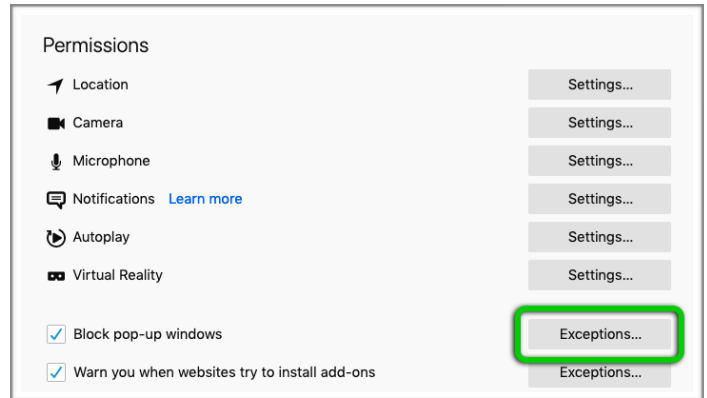
4. The “Add a site” window appears. Enter the website URL for which you wish to allow pop-ups. You can allow pop-ups for an entire domain, for example all websites that end with “lane.edu”, by entering `[*].lane.edu`. Click the “Add” button:



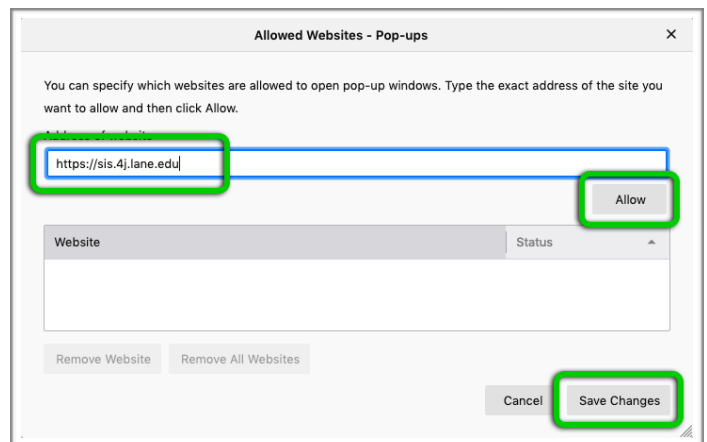
Part 2: Firefox

1. Launch Firefox, enter the following address into the address bar, and press Enter/Return:
<about:preferences#privacy>

2. Scroll down, find the “Permissions” section. Under “Permissions”, find “Block pop-up windows” and click the “Exceptions...” button:



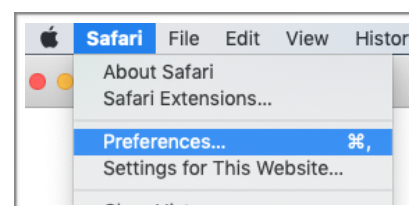
3. The “Allowed Websites - Pop-ups” window appears. Enter the website URL for which you wish to allow pop-ups. Click the “Allow” button:



4. Click the “Save Changes” button.

Part 3: Safari

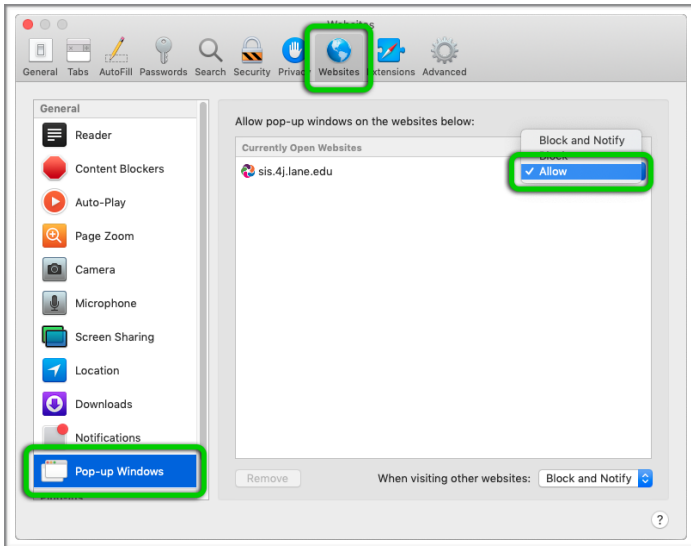
1. Launch Safari, enter the address of the website for which you wish to allow popups into the address bar, and press Enter/Return.
2. Look to the upper left area of the screen, click “Safari” and then “Preferences”:

3. Click the “Websites” tab:



4. On the left side, scroll through the list, find and click “Pop-up Windows”.
5. On the right side, find the address to which you navigated in step 1. Click the drop-down box to the right of the address, and from the list that appears click “Allow”.
6. Close the window to return to Safari.
